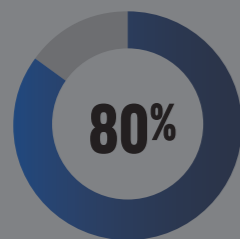


MORE TRAINEES IN JOBS

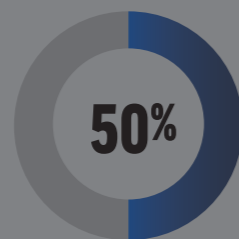


3200 more Māori and Pasifika employed in the trades meeting 10% of the demand
